"Why is there always drama when my son or any of his teammates play in any tournament? I can handle and learn to ignore the parent comments about my son's age when in reality is pretty ignorant. What I don't appreciate and feel should not go ignored is when a parent from the opposing team bursts out a comment about my son's size and weight while the game is in progress. The fact that a parent had to write an email like this at all is very sad and disturbing. Please put yourselves in their shoes. None of you would like to be the parent of a victim of bullies, and that is exactly what this is – a case of bullying.

Our events are meant to be fun – fun for the kids to participate in and fun for the parents and fans to watch. When something like this occurs, it should remind each of us to take a step back and think before we speak.

Thank you for the attention to this matter and let's teach the youth that bullying is **NEVER OK**.
