Any team that can't play on any of these days will forfeit the game and another team will fill in to give the opposing team a game. The team that can't play will lose 15-0.
- Game Times:** 9:00am, 10:15am, 11:30am, 12:45pm, 2:00pm, 3:15pm or later in some gyms.
- Divisions:** Boys: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th Girls: 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th
****7th & 8th Grade teams must come from the same school**
- Entry Fees:** \$200.00 based on 6 games. Card fee or club fee is NOT included in the entry fee. Any checks that are returned NSF will be charged a \$35.00 fee. **No entry fees refunded after the deadline date.**
- Club Membership:** **\$60.00 club fee for any club that is going to run an AAU sanctioned event.**
\$30.00 club fee, includes accident and liability insurance for players and coaches at games and practice. More than one team can be from the same club, but they must be organized as a club. Clubs are valid from September 1, 2005 to August 31, 2006.
(All teams must be a member of an AAU club)
- AAU Membership:** **2006 AAU cards will be used for the league: Player \$12.00 Coach \$14.00.** All players and coaches must have an AAU Card. **NOTE:** Anyone that coaches the team from the bench must also have an AAU card. 2006 AAU cards are valid through August 31, 2006. **REMEMBER: Membership cards don't get you into the game for free.** Only players that are playing are allowed into the game free. **Memberships can be purchased online: www.aausports.org.**
- League Rules:**
1. 7th and 8th graders can only play on a team made up of players from the same school. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** School coaches may not coach teams of the same sex, grades 7-12.
 2. A player may play for only **ONE** team during league play.
 3. Girls cannot play on boys teams and boys cannot play on girls teams.
 4. Entry fees will not be refunded after the deadline if you drop from the league.
 5. You can add players at any time as long as they have a 2006 AAU card on file.
 6. A timeline and information page will be mailed to all contact persons after the receipt of your entry by the YVSA office.
- Rules of play:** 2005-2006 High School Rules will be played.
Women's size basketball will be used for all divisions except boys 7th and 8th grades.
1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th grades: 6 minute quarters / 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th grades: 7 minute quarters
- Special Rule:** Technical or Intentional fouls – 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds.
One technical foul on a coach or fan and he/she is ejected from the gym. One technical on a player, the player sits on the bench for the remainder of the game. Officials and Gym Administrators have the right to eject a fan, coach or player. Coaches and fans must leave the building or the game will be a forfeit and the team could be sanctioned and dropped from the league.
- Forfeit Time:** Game Time - no exceptions.
- Scorekeeper:** Each team is to have **ONE** person to keep the individual score sheet that is provided by the YVSA at the score bench. One scorekeeper will be allowed into the game at no charge. Score sheets provided by the YVSA must be left with the gym supervisor.
- Coaches:** Only **ONE** coach per team is allowed into the game free, but more than one may coach, but must pay admission and have a 2006 AAU card to sit on the bench.
- Admission:** The gyms are run by clubs. The money from admissions goes back into their clubs for youth activities. This is the only way that we can run the league. Please inform your parents.
