- DATE & SITE:** December 17 & 18, 2005 in Richland, WA
- DIVISIONS:** 6th Grade Boys (6B), 7th Grade Boys (7B), 8th Grade Boys (8B)
6th Grade Girls (6G), 7th Grade Girls (7G), 8th Grade Girls (8G)
- GAMES:** All teams will play at least 4 games (2 on Saturday and 2 on Sunday).
- TIMES:** From 8:30 am to 8:15 pm on Saturday, and 8:30 am to 8:15 pm on Sunday.
- RULES:** 7 minute quarters.
- FORMAT:** This event is for teams of all ability levels. The formats will be determined based on the number of teams in each division. Last year, there were 70 teams in the tournament. Five-team round-robin and six or eight-team cross-pools with A, B, and C divisions were used exclusively so all Saturday and most Sunday games could be pre-scheduled due to constraints from teams with League games and/or out-of-town travel.
- AWARDS:** Individual awards, for up to 10 players per team, will be given to the first place teams within each division. Divisions can be split into "skill" level groupings based on the determination of the Tournament Director when completing the division's brackets.
- DEADLINE:** No specific date; registration will close when all available gym space is filled. The tournament was full almost two weeks before the tournament started last year. The only way to ensure entry is to submit early! Cancellation fee for withdrawal after scheduling is done.

- LODGING:** Motel listing with tournament rates is available on request.
- ROSTERS:** Players, or teams, may play up a grade but not down a grade (exceptions may be made for very small schools). Boys and girls can only play in their division (e.g. girls will only play in the girls division) and a player may only be assigned to one team during the tournament. The roster established for the first game will be checked and must be used throughout. Same school is not a requirement.
- MEMBERSHIP:** All athletes and coaches must have a 2006 AAU Membership Card, purchased in advance, to participate. Cards cost \$12.00 for players and \$14.00 for coaches, and are available from: Inland Empire AAU, P.O. Box 9603, Yakima, WA 98909; 509-453-2696.
