AAU Membership: All players and coaches must have a 2006 AAU Card. Costs are: Player \$12.00 Coach: \$14.00.

**NOTE:** Anyone that coaches the team from the bench must also have an AAU card. 2006 AAU cards are valid through August 31, 2006. **REMEMBER:** Membership cards don't get you into the game for free. Only players that are playing are allowed into the game free. Memberships can

be purchased online: www.aausports.org.

**Roster:** Inland Empire players must come from Eastern Washington and Idaho.

\*Boy's and Girl's teams are allowed to pick up a total of three (3) players from Oregon, Utah, Alaska, Pacific, Pacific Northwest, Wyoming and Montana Districts. There are rules that you must follow in order to pick up these players. All of this must be done before the deadline. No out-of-district additions are allowed after the deadline date. Check the rules at the web sites for each at www.aauboysbasketball.org or www.aaugirlsbasketball.org. Coaches are responsible for

all rules.

The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire tournament.

Players must have cards purchased in advance to participate.

## **Rules:**

2005-2006 High School Federation Rules.

- A. Special Rule: Any technical or intentional fouls result in an automatic 2 points and the ball awarded out of bounds.
- B. All boys 8-U, 9-U, 10-U, 11-U, 12-U will use the 28 ½ inch women's ball.
- C. Quarters: Boys 8-U, 9-U, 10-U, 11-U, 12-U and Girls 9-U, 10-U, 11-U, 12-U will play 6 minute quarters. Boys 13-U and 14-U and Girls 13-U and 14-U will play 7 minute quarters. All other age divisions will play 8 minute quarters.
- D. Overtime for all games is 2 minutes each.
- E. All age divisions must use the normal free throw line.
- F. Scoresheets will be provided for each team in their coaches packet provided at your first game site. These scoresheets MUST be given to the gym supervisors after each game.
- G. All brackets and schedules will be drawn at the Yakima AAU office. Local host is only responsible for the running of the individual gym sites and forwarding results to the AAU office throughout the day. Results will be posted throughout the tournament on www.ieaau.org.
- H. Please check your coaches letter for additional tournament information and rules.

Limit the roster to 15 players. See the boys basketball rules at <a href="www.aauboysbasketball.org">www.aauboysbasketball.org</a>. The coach is responsible for all rules set down for tournament play.

| <b>Boys Age Determining Date:</b> | September 1, 2006 shall be the determining date for the age of the competitor and shall hold true from District through the National Championship.   |

| 8 and Under / 2nd Grade           | Born on or after September 1, 1997. Exception: A player who is in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1996 can participate in the 8-Under/2 <sup>nd</sup> Grade Division.  |
| 9 and Under / 3rd Grade:          | Born on or after September 1, 1996. Exception: A player who is in the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1995 can participate in the 9-Under/3 <sup>rd</sup> Grade Division.  |
| 10 and Under / 4th Grade:         | Born on or after September 1, 1995. Exception: A player who is in the 4th Grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1994 can participate in the 10-Under/4 <sup>th</sup> Grade Division.             |
| 11 and Under / 5th Grade:         | Born on or after September 1, 1994. Exception: A player who is in the 5 <sup>th</sup> Grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1993 can participate in the 11-Under/5 <sup>th</sup> Grade Division. |
| 12 and Under / 6th Grade:         | Born on or after September 1, 1993. Exception: A player who is in the 6 <sup>th</sup> Grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1992 can participate in the 12-Under/6 <sup>th</sup> Grade Division. |
| 13 and Under / 7th Grade:         | Born on or after September 1, 1992. Exception: A player who is in the 7 <sup>th</sup> Grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1991 can participate in the 13-Under/7 <sup>th</sup> Grade Division. |
| 14 and Under / 8th Grade:         | Born on or after September 1, 1991. Exception: A player who is in the 8 <sup>th</sup> Grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1990 can participate in the 14-Under/8 <sup>th</sup> Grade Division. |
| 15 and Under / 9th Grade:         | Born on or after September 1, 1990. Exception: A player who is in the 9 <sup>th</sup> Grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1989 can participate in the 15-Under/9 <sup>th</sup> Grade Division. |
| 16 and Under / 10th Grade:        | Born on or after September 1, 1989. Exception: A player who is in the $10^{th}$ Grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1988 can participate in the 16-Under/ $10^{th}$ Grade Division.            |
| 17 and Under / Juniors:           | Born on or after September 1, 1988. Exception: A player who is in the a junior and who was born on or after September 1, 1987 can participate in the 17-Under/Junior Division.                             |
| 19 and Under / Seniors:           | Born on or after September 1, 1986 and can't participate beyond the summer of his high school  |

**Grade Confirmation:** 

Players participating under the grade eligibility exception must present birth certificate and confirmation of grade level from the school administrator. **NOTE:** Grade level is determined by players' grade on March 1, 2006. Only three players per team are allowed with the grade exception in the 9U/3rd through 14U/8th Grade. Grade confirmation information must be sent in with entry.

Grade Exception: In age groups 9U/3rd grade through 14U/8th Grade, each team roster is limited to a maximum of three (3) players who qualify under the grade exception rule. (This limitation includes pick-ups from other Districts under Rule III.D.)

## **Boys' Participation:**

A player may participate in only one age division of the AAU Boys' Basketball program for which he can qualify.

## **EXCEPTIONS:**

graduation.

- a. A player participating in the 15-Under/9th grade division may also compete in either the 16-Under/10th grade, Junior or Senior divisions. Maximum of two age divisions.
- b. A player participating in the 16-Under/10th grade division may also compete in either the junior or senior divisions.
- c. A player in the Junior boys division may also compete in the Senior division.
- d. Since games are played on the same weekend, make sure that the players' names are on the roster form of teams he wishes to participate with.
- Players who compete in more than one division under this rule must compete within the same AAU club.

## **Girls National AAU Rules:**

Limit the roster to 15 players in Inland Empire Championships. For every player over twelve (12), you will be limited to the number of players that you would be allowed to pick up if you advance to a National Championship. Players must be at the District Championships to participate in the National Finals. Any player under 18 who has attended college or junior college is eligible to play in this championship, except for NCAA Division I or II athletes. College Athletes must have a letter from the Athletic director in order to participate in the District Championships.

Girls Age Determining Date: January 1, 2006.

\*Date is set by two different national committees. We don't have any options to change (There are

NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule).

**Girls Participation:** Must participate in only ONE age division and be at the District Championship to advance.
