Grade Determining Date: The grade the participant will be in 2005/2006.

No additions or changes are permitted. Players must have cards purchased in advance to participate.

Rules: 2005-2006 High School Federation Rules. Technical Fouls; 2 points awarded and ball

out of bounds. One technical foul on a coach and he/she is ejected form gym. Two technical fouls on player and the player is ejected. Technical fouls count as personal fouls. High School Rules, 7 minute quarters. No press after 15 points or more. Men's & women's size ball will be used for all divisions, best ball available.
