AAU Membership: All players and coaches must have a 2006 AAU Card. Costs are: Player \$12.00 Coach: \$14.00.

NOTE: Anyone that coaches the team from the bench must also have an AAU card. 2006 AAU cards are valid through August 31, 2006. **REMEMBER:** Membership cards don't get you into the game for free. Only players that are playing are allowed into the game free. Memberships can

Roster: The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire tournament.

No additions or changes are permitted. Players must have cards purchased in advance to

participate.

Rules: 2005-2006 High School Federation Rules. Special Technical Foul Rule: Any technical foul or

intentional foul, two points awarded and the ball out of bounds. Check coaches letter in your

packet you will receive at the gym of your first game for additional rules.

Scorekeeper: Each team is to have ONE person to keep the individual score sheet that is provided by YVSA at

the score bench. One scorekeeper will be allowed into the game at no charge. Score sheets

provided by the YVSA must be left with the gym supervisor.
