Game Days: April 15, 22, 29, May 6, 13, 20
Any team that can't play on any of these days will forfeit the game and another team will fill in to give the opposing team a game. The team that can't play will lose 15-0.
- Game Times:** 9:00am, 10:15am, 11:30am, 12:45pm, 2:00pm, 3:15pm or later in some gyms.
- Divisions:** Boys: 9th Grade, Junior Varsity, Varsity / Girls: 9th Grade, Junior Varsity, Varsity
- Entry Fees:** \$165.00 based on 5 games. Card fee and club fee is **NOT** included in the entry fee. Any checks that are returned NSF will be charged a \$35.00 fee. **No entry fees refunded after the deadline date.**
- Club Membership:** **\$60.00 club fee for any club that is going to run an AAU sanctioned event.**
\$30.00 club fee, includes accident and liability insurance for players and coaches at games and practice. More than one team can be from the same club, but they must be organized as a club. Clubs are valid from September 1, 2006 to August 31, 2007.
(All teams must be a member of an AAU club)
- AAU Membership:** **2007 AAU cards will be used for the league: Player \$12.00 Coach \$14.00.** All players and coaches must have an AAU Card. **NOTE:** Anyone that coaches the team from the bench must have an AAU card. 2007 AAU cards are valid September 1, 2006 - August 31, 2007. **REMEMBER: Membership cards don't get you into the game for free.** Only players that are playing are allowed into the game free. **Memberships can be purchased online: www.aausports.org.**
- League Rules:**
1. Athletes can only play on a team made up of players from the same school.
NO EXCEPTIONS. WIAA rules state school coaches may not coach teams of the same sex, grades 7-12.
 2. A player may play for only **ONE** team during league play.
 3. Girls cannot play on boys teams and boys cannot play on girls teams.
 4. You can add players at any time as long as they have a 2007 AAU card on file.
 5. Teams will not be allowed to play until all membership cards and club membership have been purchased. **COACH:** It is your responsibility that **ALL** players on your team have current AAU cards. Failure to do so will result in your removal from the league with **NO REFUND** of fees paid.
- Rules of play:** 2006-2007 High School Rules will be played.
All divisions: 8 minute quarters
Overtime: 2 minutes
- Special Rule:** Technical or Intentional fouls – 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds.
One technical foul on a coach or fan and he/she is ejected from the gym. One technical on a player, the player sits on the bench for the remainder of the game. Officials and Gym Administrators have the right to eject a fan, coach or player. Coaches and fans must leave the building or the game will be a forfeit and the team could be sanctioned and dropped from the league.
- Forfeit Time:** Game Time - no exceptions.
- Scorekeeper:** Each team is to have **ONE** person to keep the individual score sheet that is provided by the YVSA at the score bench. One scorekeeper will be allowed into the game at no charge. Score sheets provided by the YVSA must be left with the gym supervisor.
- Coaches:** Only **ONE** coach per team is allowed into the game free, but more than one may coach, but must pay admission and have a 2007 AAU card to sit on the bench.
- Admission:** The gyms are run by clubs. The money from admissions goes back into their clubs for youth activities. This is the only way that we can run the league. Please inform your parents.
