LEAGUE RULES

The league will be played under Federation Rules except for the following special local rules. These rules are basic basketball rules; the official will use the rules to keep a good flow to the game. Trust & appreciate the official's knowledge of the rules.

- Special Rules of the Apple Valley Basketball League
- Girls- No 30 second shot clocks, over & back line is in use w/ a 10 second count, 5 second closely guarded count begins after a player crosses the center line.
- Half time will be 5 minutes for all games.
- Overtime will be 2 minutes, Play will until you have a winner.
- Intentional & Technical Fouls: 2 pts. & the ball out of bounds to the offended team.
- Warm up: 10 minutes or until the net official game time, whatever is longer. Gyms will be open 30 minutes before the start of the first game. Don't try to start the game early, fans that arrive on time would like to see their sons or daughters game as scheduled.
- There will be No Pressing !! & No Zones !!! for 6th Grade divisions & Lower
- 5th Grade Girls and under. 4th Grade Boys & Under. When shooting a free throw, the shooter must start from behind the normal free throw line, if the shooter steps on or over the line before the ball touches the rim, it is not a violation.
 1. The shooter can not rebound the ball at anytime. The shooter can't take control of the ball if it is tapped.
 2. A player other than the shooter must have control of the ball before the shooter can handle the ball.
 3. If the shooter does rebound the ball and gains control, this is a violation and the opponent receives the ball out of bounds.
 4. If the shooter stays behind the line, the shooter still may not rebound the ball.

Tie Breaker System

- Any situation where two (2) teams are tied, head to head competition between the teams will determine the winner.
- If more than two (2) teams tie, a point differential tie-breaker will be applied. The point differentials of the teams involved in the tie are totaled. Teams are then ranked according to the sum of the point differential. With the highest number placing first, the second highest placing second. (The maximum that you can beat a team and still gain an advantage is 15 point)
- If more than two (2) teams are still tied after the application of the formula, the point differentials of the teams are not involved in the tie are added, the results recalculated.
- The score of all forfeits shall be 15-0
- If we still have a three way tie, three way flip of the coin. Odd coin out.
