2007 AAU Three Rivers Summer Youth Basketball League

- Entry Fee:** \$260.00. We accept cash, check, money order, Visa or MasterCard. Add a \$13 convenience fee for all credit card payments. No refunds after the deadline of May 23, 2007.
- Games:** Eight (8) games played in a four week period June 4th-June 28th. Games will be played on Monday thru Thursday ONLY. Teams that have a team camp will have to play three games on two of the weeks if they are unavailable to play during one of the weeks of play.
- Entry Deadline:** Received by May 23, 2007. No team entry fee refunds after May 23rd.
- Game Sites:** High School coaches that have a gym site that they would like to use for the league, please contact Paul Campbell for information. We have been expanding our league into the Tri-Cities. Franklin and Benton County High School coaches are encouraged to participate in this league.

- Divisions:** Boys and Girls: 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, Soph, JV, Varsity
Grade Determination Date: The grade the participant will be in for the **2007-2008** school year
- Special Rules:** 8th graders through High School can **only play** on a team made up of players from the same school. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** A player may play for only **ONE team** during league play.
- Club Membership:** \$30.00 club fee, includes accident and liability insurance for players and coaches at games and practice. More than one team can be from the same club, but they must be organized as a club. Clubs are good from September 1, 2006 to August 31, 2007.
- AAU Membership:** 2007 AAU cards will be used for league. All players must have an AAU Card. **NOTE:** Anyone that coaches the team from the bench must also have an AAU card in 2007. 2007 AAU cards are valid through August 31, 2007. Go to www.aausports.org and order cards through the internet. AAU Cards are \$12 per player and \$14 per coach.
- Rules of play:** 2006-2007 High School Rules will be played.
Girls only – No 30 second clock, over and back will be called
Half-time: 5 minutes
Woman's size basketball will be used for all divisions except Boys 7th through High School.
Quarters: 6 minutes 2nd, 3rd, 4th grades / 7 minutes 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th grades / 8 minutes all others.
SPECIAL RULE: Technical fouls and Intentional fouls – 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds.
One technical foul on a player during the game for sportsmanship and the player is disqualified.
One technical foul on the coach during the game for sportsmanship, coach must leave the gym. Two technicals on a player during the Summer League season, the player will be removed from the league.
- Forfeit Time:** Game Time.
- Scorekeeper:** Each team is to have **ONE** person to keep the individual score sheet that is provided by the YVSA at the score bench. One scorekeeper will be allowed into the game at no charge. Score sheets provided by the YVSA must be left with the gym supervisor.
- Coaches:** Only **ONE** coach per team is allowed into the game free, but more than one may coach. All coaches must have a valid 2007 AAU card.
- Game Times:** 6:00pm, 7:20pm, 8:40pm
- Admission:** The gyms are run by clubs. The money goes back into their clubs for youth activities. This is the only way that we can run the league.
