Rules: Open Tournament rules.

Dress Code: There is no specific gi color requirements for the open competition. Please keep in mind, if you plan to participate in the Regional and National Karate Competitions, you must wear the AAU patch and be an AAU member. (Please see www.aausports.org for more information about becoming an AAU member)

AAU Membership: • **All participants must have a current AAU membership**

This competition will allow you to compete at the AAU Karate Super Regional competition if you are a current AAU member. Please see the above website in order to become a member. Your membership card must be presented at the time of check in to qualify.

Mandatory Equipment: Headgear for all junior athletes in kumite competition, mouth guards for all fighters, groin cup for all male fighters, knuckle pads for all fighters. White headgear and knuckle pads are required for AAU. The naugahyde type is required at Regional and National Competitions. Proper uniform and mandatory equipment is required for competition.

Optional Equipment: Shin and instep guard for juniors, shin guards for adults that are not in the advanced 19-34 year old group, chest protectors for female and junior fighters, certified prescription safety glasses with strap or soft contact lenses. (Please ask about specifics on chest guards for Regionals or Nationals.)

Disallowed: *Headbands, jewelry, colored t-shirts, metal hair clips, rolled up sleeves and pant legs, eyeglasses during fighting competition, and long and/or dirty fingernails.*

Divisions: Athletes may qualify for the Regional Championships in the following divisions: Kata, Kumite, Kobudo, Synchronized Kata, and Team Kumite by attending the Inland Empire Karate AAU Tournament. However, synchronized Kata and Team Kumite are division that will not be offered at this event. To qualify in team events for the Regional Championships, athletes must participate in their individual divisions. For the purpose of preparing Kata and Kobudo teams for Regionals, junior teams may combine males and females. Teams consist of three members. Adult divisions may not mix genders.

There will be a breakdown of each age group according to karate experience. Each athlete must wear the designated belt color for their level of experience.

| Tourn. Experience | Level | Belt Color |
|----------------------------|-----------------|-------------------|
| Less than 1 year | Beginner | White |
| <i>1 year, less than 2</i> | <i>Novice</i> | <i>Green</i> |
| 2 years, less than 4 | Intermediate | Brown |
| <i>4 or more years</i> | <i>Advanced</i> | <i>Black</i> |

The divisions shall try to apply male and female competitors separately. However, genders, ages and experience may be mixed for Kata, Kobudo, and Kumite at this event in order to allow competitors a chance to compete. This may or may not affect placing. An athlete must compete in Kobudo at the same experience level as they competed in Kata and Kumite.
