Eligibility: This is an elite boys' tournament. Teams are selected by invitation only. If you would like to be considered, please contact us. All players must have one year or more of high school eligibility remaining as of September 2011 (current juniors or younger) to compete in this open division tournament.

Registration deadline: To register please fill out the attached team registration form. The completed entry form must be in the office by Monday, May 9, 2011 in order to guarantee your approved team a place in the tournament.

Tournament Fees: \$450.00 (not including any AAU membership cards). Make check (only one check per team) payable to: Spokane AAU Basketball. Teams may also pay with a credit card (Visa or M/C) by providing the information required on the entry form. Any checks returned NSF will be charged a \$30.00 fee. Coaches, athletes and spectators can attend any game during the course of the event at no cost. **We are not charging a gate fee.**

AAU membership: All players and coaches must have a 2010-2011 AAU Card. An athlete's membership card costs \$12.00. Each coach (one head coach and up to two assistant coaches) sitting on the bench must also have a current AAU Card, which costs \$14.00. AAU Cards must be purchased online at www.aausports.org. Please have your AAU Cards on hand throughout the event.

Concussion Requirements: Pursuant to Washington State Law HB1824 (The Lystedt Law) all coaches, athletes, and parents/guardians are required to complete certain criteria regarding the recognition and treatment of head injuries during sporting events. The head coach or team contact must complete the attached compliance waiver and return it to Spokane AAU Basketball along with the completed team entry form. Each player and coach must complete and return their individual concussion form to the Spokane AAU Basketball office as a part of the team registration packet.

Event format: All teams are guaranteed four scheduled games. The teams will compete in pool play first and then all teams will be seeded out once pool play is complete.

Rules of play: High School Federation Rules will be in effect. Highlighted rules include the following:

- Games will always start at scheduled time, never earlier, and later only if the previous game is running late
- Games will consist of two 16 minute halves with stopping clock
- The 35-second shot clock will be in effect
- Minimum warm-up time: Pregame 5 minutes; Halftime 2 minutes; Between quarters 1 minute
- 60 second time outs per game: 3
- 30 second time outs per game: 2
- 60 second time out per overtime period no carryovers: 1
- 6 Fouls
- 3 minutes per overtime period
- Forfeit of a game 10 minutes after the scheduled start time
- A player may be rostered only on one team during the tournament
- The established roster (changes will be accepted through Monday, May 16) will be used throughout the tournament
- Participants (coaches, spectators and/or players) will be disqualified from the "Game in Progress" if assessed a second technical foul. Officials and gym administrators have the right to eject anyone who may compromise the

flow of a game or the safety of the event. Any coach, spectator or player ejected from a game will be suspended from the entire next game. A suspended coach or spectator must leave the premises. A suspended player may remain on the bench or in the stands. Any individual assessed a third technical foul during the tournament will be disqualified from further tournament play, must leave the premises, and cannot return for the duration of the tournament.

Sportsmanship: Give Respect – Get Respect! Coaches, athletes and spectators must exhibit good sportsmanship during the tournament by showing respect for teammates, coaches, opponents, officials and support staff. Coaches are ultimately responsible for the behavior of their players and spectators. Good sportsmanship supports the values of the game and our goal is to promote healthy competition in a positive and safe environment. We reserve the right to have a team forfeit a game or to have a team suspended from the tournament if coaches, athletes, or spectators become unruly and/or unmanageable.
