**Games:** All teams will play a minimum of four games.

**AAU Membership:** All athletes and head coaches that participate in any AAU event must have a 2014 AAU card.

Athlete membership cards cost \$14 and coach cards are \$16. These cards are valid September 1, 2013 – August 31, 2014. Participants are encouraged to visit the <a href="www.aausports.org">www.aausports.org</a> to obtain their membership. AAU membership must be obtained before the competition begins as memberships are no longer instant. Please allow 10 days for membership to be processed.

**The Lystedt Law:** Washington State has passed a law requiring youth coaches, athletes and parents/guardians

complete certain criteria regarding the recognition and treatment of head injuries during sporting events. All participating teams must complete the attached form and return it as part of

their registration. Your entry form will not be accepted without this form.

**Age Determining Date:** The grade the participant is in as of March 1, 2014.

**Roster:** The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire tournament.

No additions or changes are permitted. Players may play on only one team in the tournament.

**Rules:** 2013-2014 High School Federation Rules. Special Technical Foul Rule: Any technical foul and

intentional fouls, two points awarded and the ball out of bounds. Check coaches letter in your

packet you will receive at your first game for additional rules.

**Awards:** Apparel awards given to the first and second place teams. Third place awards determined by the

size of the tournament.

# CONCUSSION LAW REQUIREMENTS Required by AAU Event Operators to participate in AAU sanction events.

HB1824, otherwise known as the Zachery Lystedt Law, was signed into law on May 14, 2009. It requires, as of July 26, 2009, that additional steps be taken regarding concussions in private non-profit youth athletic programs using school district facilities.

This bill requires training and documentation which AAU Member Clubs must adhere to. AAU players and their parents/guardians must meet these minimum requirements:

- 1. All AAU member coaches will have to take training on the nature and risk of concussions and head injury including continuing to play after a concussion or head injury.
- 2. On a yearly basis, a concussion and head injury information sheet shall be signed and returned by the youth athlete and athlete's parents/guardian prior to the youth athlete's initiating practice or competition.
- 3. All athletes suspected of suffering a concussion or brain injury will be removed from practice or competition and not returned to play until cleared in writing by a licensed health care provider trained in the evaluation and management of concussions (Medical Doctors, Doctor of Osteopathy, Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner, Physicians Assistants, and *Certified* Athletic Trainers).
