

CONCUSSION LAW AND SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST REQUIREMENTS

HB1824, otherwise known as the Zachery Lystedt Law, was signed into law on May 14, 2009. It requires, as of July 26, 2009, that additional steps be taken regarding concussions in private non-profit youth athletic programs using school district facilities. Sudden Cardiac Arrest SB 5083 sec 3 became law on july 15, 2015, which also requires educational training.

# Hoopin' in the Methow 2015 Rules

#### AAU BASKETBALL RULES 2015

- \* The main objective of this tournament is participation for all athletes to prepare for the upcoming basketball season. Coaches are encouraged to begin the game with starters yet sub in during the game to give players equal playing time. This is a game after all and we understand if the game is close giving a couple minutes in the game that a coach can sub players in as necessary to go for a win.
- \* All players and coaches must be able to show a current AAU membership card.
- \* All teams will play a minimum of four games in a round robin fashion with no championship.
- \* High School Federation Rules will apply with the following exceptions:
- o No shot clocks, we will us a 10 second backcourt count instead.
- o Technical Foul: Automatic 2 points to the opposing team and possession of the ball.
- o Two Technical Fouls disqualifies the coach or player for the remainder of the game.
- o Three Technical Fouls disqualifies the coach or player for the remainder of the tournament.
- o Coach, parent or player ejection: Ejected for the remainder of the tournament and not allowed in the gym or school.
- \* 7 minute quarters will be played.
- \* A Girl's regulation basketball (28.5) will be used for all games.
- \* The 3-point line will be in effect on courts that are so marked.
- \* Two 30 second and 3- full (60 second) time outs will be allowed per team per game. Time out may be called by the coach or player when their team has the ball. A defensive time out may be called on a dead ball.
- \* Overtime periods will be two minutes in length and jump ball will determine possession. Each team will get one additional time out, plus any carryovers for each additional period. Length of warm-up times, quarter and half-time breaks are flexible and will be determined by officials at each game.
- \* Running clock will be in effect in the 4th quarter of any game with a 20 point margin at the start of the 4th quarter. Clock will stop if the margin drops below 20 points.
- \* Coaches are responsible for their crowd behavior.
- \* Each team is required to provide a scorekeeper(free admission.) The winning teams MUST leave their score sheet at the scorekeeper's desk otherwise they will be charged with a forfeit.
- \*Only Basketball shoes on gym floors

#### \*All children need to be supervised at all times
