AAU Membership: All players and coaches must have a 2018-2019 AAU Card. NOTE: Anyone that coaches the team from the bench must also have an AAU card. AAU cards are valid through August 31, 2019. REMEMBER: Membership cards don't get you into the game for free. Only players that are playing are allowed into the game free. Memberships must be purchased online: www.aausports.org.

The Lystedt Law: Washington State has passed a law requiring youth coaches, athletes and parents/guardians complete certain criteria regarding the recognition and treatment of head injuries during sporting events. All participating teams must complete the attached form and return it to the above mailing address.

Tournament Rules:

1. The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire tournament. No additions or changes are permitted.
 - A player may play for ONE team only during the tournament.
 - Girls cannot play on boy's teams and boys cannot play on girl's teams.
 - Scorekeepers – each team is to have ONE person to keep the individual score sheet that is provided in your coach's packet. One scorekeeper per team will be allowed into the game free of charge. Please leave score sheets with the gym supervisor after your game.
 - Coaches – Only ONE coach per team is allowed into the game free, but more than one may coach.

Admission fees: \$6 Adult, \$4 Student each day. PLEASE INFORM YOUR PARENTS!

Rules of play: 2018-2019 High School Federation Rules, with the following exceptions:

- No shot clock
- 2nd and 3rd grade boys and girls divisions will use the Junior basketball (27.5") and 4th -8th grade girls and boys will use women's size basketball (28.5").
- Quarters: 2nd – 4th grade: 6 minutes / 5th – 8th grade: 7 minutes
- Overtime: 2 minutes each
- Technical or Intentional Fouls – 2 points awarded and the ball out of bounds.
- One technical foul on a coach and they must sit while coaching remainder of game; second technical= ejection. A technical foul on a fan and he/she is ejected from the gym. Two technicals on a player and the player must sit on the bench for the remainder of the game. Officials and gym administrators have the right to eject a fan, player or coach. Coaches and fans must leave the gym completely.
