- AAU **Youth** Athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins, except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connection.

Be Prepared: Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at an event. Due to background screenings, please allow up to 10 days for the adult memberships to be processed.

The Lystedt Law: Washington State has passed a law requiring youth coaches, athletes and parents/guardians complete certain criteria regarding the recognition and treatment of head injuries during sporting events. All participating teams must complete the attached form and return it to the above mailing address.

Tournament Rules:

1. The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire tournament. No additions or changes are permitted.
 - A player may play for ONE team only during the tournament.
 - Girls cannot play on boy's teams and boys cannot play on girl's teams.
 - Scorekeepers – each team is to have ONE person to keep the individual score sheet that is provided in your coach's packet. One scorekeeper per team will be allowed into the game free of charge. Please leave score sheets at the score table with the clock keeper after your game.
 - Coaches – Only ONE coach per team is allowed into the game free.

Admission fees: \$6 Adult, \$4 Student each day. PLEASE INFORM YOUR PARENTS!

Rules of play: 2019-202 High School Federation Rules, with the following exceptions:

- No shot clock.
- 2nd and 3rd grade boys and girls divisions will use the Junior basketball (27.5") and 4th -8th grade girls and boys will use women's size basketball (28.5").
- Quarters: 2nd – 4th grade division quarters are 6 minutes. 5th – 8th grade division quarters are 7 minutes.
- Overtime: 2 minutes each, with one additional time out for each team.
- Technical or Intentional Fouls: 2 points awarded to the opposing team AND they receive the ball out of bounds.
 - Two technicals on a player and the player must sit out the remainder of the game.
- If a coach receives a technical foul, they must sit while coaching the remainder of game; a second technical = ejection from the gym.
- If a fan receives a technical foul, he/she is ejected from the gym.

Officials and gym administrators have the right to eject a fan, player or coach. If ejected, coaches or fans must leave the gym completely.

CONCUSSION LAW REQUIREMENTS

Required by AAU Event Operators to participate in AAU sanction events.

HB1824, otherwise known as the Zachery Lystedt Law, was signed into law on May 14, 2009. It requires, as of July 26, 2009, that additional steps be taken regarding concussions in private non-profit youth athletic programs using school district facilities.

This bill requires training and documentation which AAU Member Clubs must adhere to. AAU players and their parents/guardians must meet these minimum requirements:

1. All AAU member coaches will have to take training on the nature and risk of concussions and head injury including continuing to play after a concussion or head injury.
2. On a yearly basis, a concussion and head injury information sheet shall be signed and returned by the youth athlete and athlete's parents/guardian prior to the youth athlete's initiating practice or competition.
3. All athletes suspected of suffering a concussion or brain injury will be removed from practice or competition and not return to play until cleared in writing by a licensed health care provider trained in the evaluation and management of concussions (Medical Doctors, Doctor of Osteopathy, Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner, Physicians Assistants, and *Certified* Athletic Trainers).
