- **AAU Membership:** All Participants must have a current AAU Membership. AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event
AAU membership must be obtained before the competition begins except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connect. Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU website www.aausports.org to obtain their membership.
- **Scorekeepers:** Each team should have one person assigned as a scorekeeper for each game. The home team, as designated by the game officials, will be the official scorebook in case there are any discrepancies. Scorekeepers are part of the officiating crew and no comments directed at the official by the scorekeepers will be tolerated.
- **Admission:** Tournament Passes available at gyms. One coach and one scorekeeper will be admitted with no charge. Coaches and scorekeepers will receive wristbands in their welcome packets upon check-in.

No entry will be accepted without payment of entry fee and submission of rosters. Entries will be accepted after that date on a space available basis. No team will be allowed to play unless the Concussion Law Compliance and Sudden Cardiac Arrest forms are completed and turned in to the Tournament Director.

WENATCHEE AAU BOYS & GIRLS INVITE**

High School Federation Rules except as follows:

1. Tournament roster must be submitted with registration; any changes must be made prior to the first day of tournament.
2. Players may only play on 1 team in the tournament
3. Teams will receive a 5-minute warm up
4. 8 – Minute quarters for grades 7-9. Ball size: 29.5 (boys), 28.5 (girls)
5. 7 – Minute quarters for grades 4-6. Ball size: 28.5
6. 5 – minute half-time
7. 2 – minute overtime periods
8. Time Outs: 3 full (1-minute) and two – 30 second. One additional time out per overtime period. Regulation time outs do NOT carry over into OT period.
9. **Mercy Rule:** A running clock will be used in the 4th quarter only when a team is ahead by 20 or more. Running clock will continue even if the lead is brought under 20 points.
 - a. **No press allowed when lead exceeds 15 points**
 1. No half-court trap when lead exceeds 15 points.
 2. Defenders MUST retreat inside the 3-point arc until the ball crosses half court.
 3. The 10 second back court rule will start once the defense has retrieved inside the 3-point arc.

10. Technical Fouls – Team is awarded 2 points and the ball.
 - a. 2 Technical fouls on a coach results in ejection from gym.
 - b. Player technical fouls also count as a personal/team foul.
 - c. Technical foul on fans will be charged to the appropriate team and administered as above. Fan will be ejected from gym.
13. Game ball and home team is chosen by the referees.
14. Game time is forfeit time. Contact the Tournament Director or assigned gym manager if there are questions about this. The team awarded the forfeit will receive “plus 15 points” in case there is a tiebreaker.

Tiebreakers:

1. Head to head
2. Least points given up amongst tied teams
3. Point differential amongst tied teams; maximum + /- 15 points per game
4. Least points given up all games
5. Point differential all games
