Pullman Basketball Kickoff Rules



1. NFHS rules govern all play unless otherwise specified.
2. This is a pre-season jamboree. Each team will receive three games with no tournament play. There will be no division winners declared. **In addition to providing pre-season play to prepare players, this will serve as a pre-season officials training opportunity. Development of officials is every bit as important to the sport of basketball as development of players. Some officials will be working live games for the first time at this tournament.** Harassment or unsportsmanlike conduct towards officials may result in removal of player, coach, or fan from the remaining duration of the tournament.
3. Rosters must be submitted prior to the first game for each team and all players must be registered with AAU.
4. Games are 20 minute halves (running clock). The clock will stop during the last 2 minutes of each half. If a team is ahead by more than 15 points at any point during the last two minutes the clock will run. Once the 15 point threshold is met the clock will continue to run even if the lead falls below 15. Three (3) minute half time.
5. Two (2) timeouts per game. Overtime(s) will be one minute. No additional timeouts, may keep unused timeouts.
6. Each team should provide a scorekeeper. Scorekeepers must remain impartial and professional.
7. Home team is listed second on the schedule and is responsible to provide ball for each game. Grades 4-6 will used intermediate size (28.5") basketball.
8. A technical foul will result in two (2) points for the opposing team. Two (2) technical fouls by any one player or coach will result in automatic suspension from play or coaching for remainder of the day.
9. Press Rule: No pressing allowed by a team who is ahead by 15 points.
10. Players and fans should remain off the court during half time or between games unless your team is playing in the current game.
11. It is preferred that teams have reversible or two different colored uniforms with numbers.
12. Please inform your team and fans to be considerate to the officials and the school facilities. This will assist us in our ability to host future basketball events.
13. **AAU takes a strong stance against fighting, threats and disruptive behavior. Anyone involved in such behavior, including but not limited to, athletes, coaches, parents, spectators, vendors, officials or other event attendees maybe removed from the event. Additionally, athletes and teams may be disqualified from the event.**

Entry Deadline: Entries must be received by **Saturday, November 9**. Space is limited, first come, first serve. Entries are not guaranteed until payment has been received.

Schedule

All games will be played on Sunday, November 17 in Pullman. Primary location will be Lincoln Middle School. Other sites in Pullman may be added if necessary. Schedules will be available no later than Tuesday, November 12.

Games

Each team will play three games. Games will be 20-minute halves running clock with clock stopping during the last 2 minutes of each half.

Uniforms

It is preferred that teams have reversible or two different colored uniforms with numbers.

AAU Membership

This event is licensed by Amateur Athletic Union of the US. Players and coaches must have current AAU registration. AAU membership is not included as part of the entry fee and must be obtained prior to competition. Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU web site www.aausports.org to obtain their membership.

Divisions

This is a boys 4th-8th tournament. Teams must register by the oldest grade of any player on the roster. Divisions may be combined due to limited number of teams. Divisions have limited space and will be filled first come, first serve. Space is not reserved until payment has been received.

HB 1824 & SB 5083 Club Compliance

Washington State law, HB 1824, also known as the Zachery Lystedt Law, mandates additional steps be taken regarding concussions in youth sports programs using school districts. Additionally, SB 5083 sec 3, requires steps regarding Sudden Cardiac Arrest. All teams must complete and return the AAU Member Club Compliance Form verifying that players and coaches have completed received information regarding concussion and sudden cardiac arrest as outlined in HB 1824 & SB 5083.

AAU Member Club Compliance Form

Concussion Law and Sudden Cardiac Arrest Requirements

HB1824 was signed into law on May 14, 2009. It requires, as of July 26, 2009, that additional steps be taken regarding concussions in private non-profit youth athletic programs using school district facilities. Sudden Cardiac Arrest SB 5083 sec 3 became law on July 15, 2015 which also requires educational training.

These bills require training and documentation which AAU Member Clubs must adhere to. AAU players and their parents/guardians must meet these minimum requirements: Go to www.ieaa.org upper right hand side of the web site Lystedt Law information:

1. All AAU member coaches will have to take training on the nature and risk of concussions and head injury including continuing to play after a concussion or head injury and the Sudden Cardiac Arrest information provided.
2. On a yearly basis, a concussion and head injury/Sudden Cardiac Arrest information sheet shall be signed and returned by the youth athlete and athlete's parents/guardian prior to the youth athlete's initiating practice or competition.
3. All athletes suspected of suffering a concussion or brain injury will be removed from practice or competition and not returned to play until cleared in writing by a licensed health care provider trained in the evaluation and management of concussions (Medical Doctors, Doctor of Osteopathy, Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner, Physicians Assistants, and Certified Athletic Trainers).
