MUST HAVE A CURRENT 2022-2023 AAU Membership Card Memberships must be purchased online: www.aausports.org. REMEMBER: Membership cards don't get you into the game for free.

League Rules: Players must be in grades 8-12 grade to participate in this league.

A player may play for only **ONE** team during league play.

Girls cannot play on boys teams and boys cannot play on girls teams.

Entry fees will not be refunded after the deadline if you drop from the league.

Players cannot wear jewelry of any kind during games, even if it is taped and/or covered up.

Players cannot switch teams once games have started.

We reserve the right to refuse a team's entry into our events.

Scorekeepers – each team is to have one person to keep the individual score sheet that is provided at the score bench. One scorekeeper per team will be allowed into the game free of charge. Please leave scoresheets with the gym supervisor after your game.

Coaches – Only one coach per team is allowed into the game free, only one coach is allowed on The bench during the game.

10. Admission – The gyms are run by clubs – the proceeds from admissions goes back to their clubs for youth activities. ADULTS - \$5.00 STUDENTS - \$3.00 - PLEASE INFORM YOUR PARENTS!

Rules of play: 2022-2023 High School Rules will be played, with the following exceptions.

1. All games must start with 4 players on each team

No Zone or designed trapping defense permitted

Two 15 minute halves 3 minute Halftime

a. Clock will run continuously stopping on all time outs and injuries.

b. Clock will also stop on every dead ball during the last minute of each half.

A 2 minute overtime period will be used if there is a tie.

NO Stalling is allowed

Each team is allowed one 30 second timeout per half.

All games will be officiated by a single AAU Certified Referee

One Free throw will be shot for ALL fouls up to the last minute of the game. At that Time fouls will equal 2 points and ball out of bounds. The one foul shot made is worth 2 points.

9. Each team is responsible for their Scorekeeper.

10. Maximum roster is 6 players

11. Technical or Intentional fouls: Automatic 2 points and the ball out of bounds.

12. Technical on coach or player, the coach or player is removed from the game and Gym.

13. Technical on a fan can be call by the Official, 2 points and ball out of bounds.

14. Forfeit time – Game time. You must have 4 players to start the game. Officials shall run a shortened game (2 10 minute running halves with less than 4 players)

Division Awards: The first place team in each division will receive championship Awards.
