SANCTION: Sanctioned by the Inland Empire AAU.

FILLING DIVISIONS:

There is a limit on the total number of games the facilities will accommodate. Entries will be accepted on a first received, first honored basis, and balanced between divisions to provide the maximum opportunity for teams to participate.

**AAU MEMBERSHIP:** 

All athletes that participate in any AAU event must have a 2000/01 AAU card and each team must be from an AAU club. For information on both athlete and club membership contact the Inland Empire AAU Office in Yakima (509) 453-2696. AAU cards will not be available at the tournament site.

**ROSTER:** 

The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire tournament. No additions or changes are permitted. A roster limit of twelve players is established for this tournament.

**RULES:** 

- \*\* High School Federation Rules will be applied.
- \*\* Special Technical Foul Rule: Any technical foul will result in award of an automatic two points to the team, plus the ball out of bounds.
- \*\* The 28 ½ inch women's ball will be used, except for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Boy's Games.
- \*\* Quarter times will be 6 minutes for 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Teams; 7 minutes for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Teams.
- \*\* There is no 30 second clock for Girl's Games.
- \*\* A press is not allowed with a 15+ point lead.

**AWARDS:** 

Individual awards to the players on the top two teams in each Division.

Team plaques to the top four teams in each Division.
