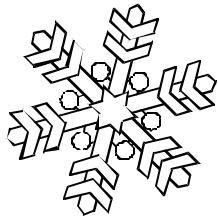

**Games:** All teams are guaranteed four games. Limited space available.

**AAU Membership:** All athletes that participate in any AAU event must have a 2000 AAU card. Membership cost is \$10.00 and is good for all AAU sanctioned events. AAU cards can be obtained by calling Paul Campbell at: (509) 453-2696.

**Grade Determination:** The grade that the participant is currently enrolled in.  
Girls 4th and 5th, Boys 6th, 7th, & 8th grades.

**Roster:** The roster must be established at the time of application. AAU numbers must be listed on the roster. No team member will be allowed to participate without a valid AAU number.

**General Rules:** High School Federation Rules; Technical Foul Rule: two points and possession of the ball. No press allowed if ahead by 15 points or more. 4th-6th grade use 28.5" ball, 7 minute quarters. 7th-8th grade use full size ball, 8 minute quarters. Team plaques and T-shirts will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place.

**Cancellation Policy:** Cancellations can be made at any time up to three weeks prior to the tournament for a \$50.00 refund. Cancellations later than three weeks prior to the tournament will receive no refund.

**Entry Deadline:** Postmarked by November 22nd, 2000

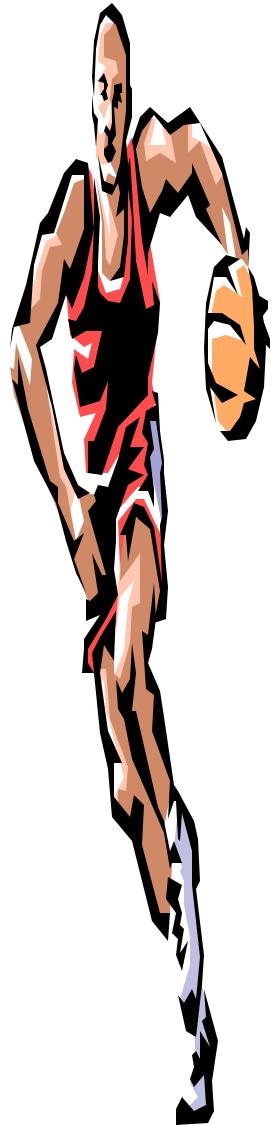
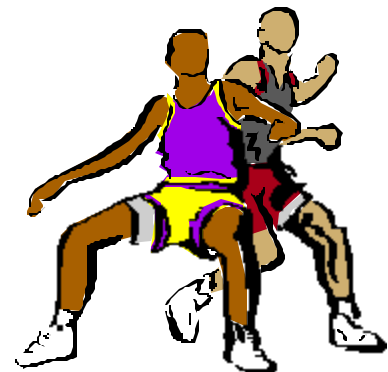

## **Eastmont AAU Basketball 1st Annual Snowflake Tournament**

1. All teams will play a minimum of four games. The possibility exists for some teams to play five or more games.
2. In the event of a tie in win/loss record, in pooled play only, the following procedure will be followed:
  - A. 1st tie breaker will be head to head competition.
  - B. 2nd tie breaker will be the team with the fewest points scored against.
  - C. 3rd tie breaker will be the total points scored.
  - D. 4th tie breaker will be a coin toss.
3. High School Federation Rules will apply with the following exceptions:
  - A. Technical Foul: Automatic 2 points to the opposing team, and possession of the ball out of bounds.
  - B. Two technical fouls disqualifies a coach or a player from the remainder of the game.
  - C. Three technical fouls disqualifies a coach or a player from the remainder of the tournament.
4. The tenth team foul in each half activates the automatic two shot rule.
5. Each team has 3 full time outs and 2 twenty second time outs per game that can be taken at any time.
6. No press if ahead by 15 or more points.
7. 4th, 5th, 6th grades will use 28.5" ball and play 7 minute quarters. 7th and 8th grades will use a regular size ball and play 8 minute quarters. There are no tournament balls. "Best ball" available will be used.
8. Overtime periods will be two minutes in length and jump ball will determine possession. Each team will get one additional time out plus any carryovers for each additional period. Length of warm-up times, quarter and half time breaks are flexible and will be determined by officials at each game.
9. Each team is required to provide a scorekeeper, home team is the official book; home team will be determined by the officials.
10. Running clock will be in effect in 4th quarter of any game with a 20 point margin at the start of the 4th quarter. Clock will stop if the margin drops below 20 points.
11. In the event that a team doesn't show up for a game, that game will be forfeited at ten minutes past the designated start time, as determined by the officials.
