TECHNICAL FOUL RULE: Any technical foul awards automatic two points to

bounds.

INTENTIONAL FOUL: Any foul that is deliberate of intentional means 2

foul shots for the opposing team and the opposing

team gets the ball out wherever the whistle is blown.

PRESS RULE: Any team with a score advantage of 15 points is

required to pull of the full court press. After one warning from the official, if the press is not discontinued, the officials will award a technical

foul to the coach's bench.
