Team with best record is the first place team. . Pool play tiebreaker: 1. When two teams are tied, head to head competition will determine the winner. 2. If more than two teams tie, a point differential tie breaker will be applied. The point differentials of the team involved in the tie breaker are totaled. Teams then are ranked according to the sum of the point differential- with the highest team placing first and the second highest second. The maximum that you can beat a team and still gain an advantage is 15 points. If more than 2 teams are still tied after the application of the formula, the point differentials of the teams not involved in the tie are added, and the results are recalculated. The score of all forfeits is 15-0. Practice games do not count in pool standings.

Tournament rules: 2001-2002 High school rules will be played. Technical fouls: 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds. 8 minute quarters will be played. No pressing after one team is ahead by 20 points. All overtimes will be 2 minutes.
