Team with best record is the first place team. Pool play tiebreaker: 1. When two teams are tied, head to head competition will determine the winner. 2. If more than two teams tie, a point differential tie breaker will be applied. The point differentials of the team involved in the tie breaker are totaled. Teams then are ranked according to the sum of the point differential- with the highest team placing first and the second highest second. The maximum that you can beat a team and still gain an advantage is 15 points. If
